# **Application Guidelines for Enrollment in September 2023** (January Selection Process)

For applicants who wish to choose faculty members of the University of Tsukuba as their supervisor

#### <u>Important Notice</u>

Travel to the University of Bordeaux (France) or the National Taiwan University (Taiwan) may not be possible due to the ever-changing COVID-19 situations in these universities or countries. In such cases, students will take online or on-demand courses provided by the University of Bordeaux and the National Taiwan University while staying in Japan.

"Food and Health" is a global issue, extending beyond national borders. With the aim to develop highly specialized professionals who can both appreciate "Food and Health" and be active internationally, the University of Tsukuba established the International Joint Degree Master's Program in Agro-Biomedical Science in Food and Health in cooperation with the University of Bordeaux (France) and National Taiwan University (Taiwan). Students of this program attend lectures and receive research guidance for at least a semester at each university and will receive a "Master of Agro-Biomedical Science in Food and Health" degree upon graduation, jointly awarded by the three universities. If you wish to enroll in this program, please read the application guidelines below before applying. Those who wish to choose a faculty member of the University of Bordeaux or National Taiwan University as their supervisor cannot apply through these guidelines.

#### 1. Prospective Students

This program seeks students with a background in medical or agro-biological resources science and a cooperative spirit who are strongly determined to innovate and contribute to the future of society and mankind by overcoming national and academic boundaries to assertively tackle global-scale issues related to the fields of health and food.

### 3. Eligibility for Application

Eligible applicants of the Graduate School must meet one of the following requirements, in accordance



with the provisions of the School Education Act.

- (A) No eligibility screening is required for the following individuals:
  - Individuals who have graduated or who will graduate from a Japanese four-year university by August 2023.
  - Individuals who have graduated from a university outside Japan that implements 16 or more years of school curriculum up to university graduation, and earned a bachelor's degree by August 2023.
  - Others (for applicants who do not fall into the above 2 categories)
- (B) Eligibility screening is required for the following individuals:
  - Individuals who have graduated from a junior college or high school
  - Individuals who have graduated from a vocational school or miscellaneous educational institution
  - Individuals who have graduated from a university in a foreign country that implements less than 16 years of school curriculum
  - Others (for applicants who do not fall into the above 3 categories)

Individuals expected to undergo eligibility screening must contact the Admissions Staff of the International Joint Degree Master's Program in Agro-Biomedical Science in Food and Health (see below, **13. Contact Us**) in advance. The required screening documents **must** be submitted by **November 25, 2022**.

#### 4. Notices Before Applying

It is recommended, but not required, to contact your prospective supervisor in advance.

A minimum score of 61 for TOEFL iBT, 600 for TOEIC, or 5.0 for IELTS is required as this program conducts all lectures and research guidance in English.

Scores from the TOEFL iBT Home Edition test can be accepted as certification of English proficiency.

#### 5. Examination Fee

JPY 30,000 (except for government-sponsored (Japanese Government *Monbukagakusho* Scholarship) foreign students)

- 1. Payment Period: December 1, 2022 December 16, 2022
- 2. Procedure: Payment must be made by a credit card or at a convenience store. (For details, refer to the attachment.)

#### 6. Documents to be Submitted

We will review applicant contents and bachelor's program results, purposes and plans of study in this program, career plans after graduation, and English proficiency. We will also evaluate the applicant's background relating to "food and health," determination to solve global issues concerning "food and health," and aptitude for international and interdisciplinary study based on the documents below. All documents from (1) to (10) must be prepared in English. If you are submitting in a language other than English under unavoidable circumstances, attach the English translation along with the original.

#### (1) Application Form (designated form)

Attach the "Certificate of Payment" issued by a convenience store or a credit card to the designated



column of the application form.

#### (2) Curriculum Vitae/Employment Record (designated form)

Submission of the Employment Record is required only for applicants who have a work history.

#### (3) Reference Card/Photo Card (designated form)

Paste an identical photograph on both cards.

### (4) Essay (designated form)

Fill in your motivation and background for entrance to this program and your research plan during the program (including purpose and plan of study plus career plan) within 500 words in English.

The font must be Times New Roman and the size 11 points. Any alteration in style and/or insertion of figures and graphs will be rejected.

#### (5) (Expected) Graduation Certificate/Academic Transcript

If any subject mentioned in the transcript has been certified because of a transfer, submit the academic transcript from the previous school, etc., along with the latest transfer.

If your GPA is not mentioned in the transcript and you possess other GPA certification, submit it too.

#### (6) Degree Certificate

Applicants who graduated from a foreign university must submit a document (degree certificate) to certify that they have a degree equivalent to a bachelor's degree.

Applicants who have obtained a qualification for application from the National Institution for Academic Degrees and University Evaluation must submit a certificate of the degree awarded (a certificate of acceptance of application for the degree), an academic transcript, and other certificates related to earning the degree.

#### (7) Letter of Recommendation

This should be obtained from your supervisor, homeroom teacher, etc. (with affixed seal or signature). If it is written in a language other than English, attach the English translation.

#### (8) Documents to Prove English Proficiency

You are required to submit an original copy of your TOEIC Official Score Certificate, TOEFL Examinee (Test Taker) Score Report (Scores of the TOEFL iBT Home Edition test can be also accepted), or IELTS Academic Module Test Report Form. Scores on a test taken after January 2021 are valid. Photocopies are not accepted.

Applicants eligible for an exemption from submitting TOEIC, TOEFL, or IELTS academic score requirements include the following;

- 1) Those whose first or native language is English
- 2) Those from a country where English is an official language
- 3) Those who completed undergraduate courses fully conducted in English.

If you fall under one of the above categories and wish to request this exemption, submit a letter that briefly summarizes your own linguistic background to support your request.

#### (9) Letter of Approval for Entrance Examination

Applicants who currently attend a university or graduate school (except those who are expected to graduate by August 2023) and those who currently work for a government agency, school, or company (except for part-time workers) must submit a letter of approval for taking the entrance examination issued by the head of their university (or department). (Free Format A4 size)

Applicants who plan to leave their company to enroll in the graduate school may submit a written document (affixed with their own seal) as a substitute for this letter of approval. In this case, the applicants must submit a certificate of resignation at the time of the enrollment procedure.

# (10) Certificate of Government-Sponsored (Japanese Government *Monbukagakusho* Scholarship) Foreign Student

If you are enrolled in another university at the time of application, submit a Certificate of Government-



Sponsored (Japanese Government *Monbukagakusho* Scholarship) Foreign Student issued by the university.

#### 7. Application Procedure

Submit originals of all required certificates and supporting documents by registered mail before the application deadline.

Application submission period: December 1, 2022 – December 16, 2022

Registered mail must arrive at the GIP-TRIAD office by December 16, 2022.

#### 8. Screening Criteria

Screening of documents will proceed based on the documents mentioned in "6. Documents to be Submitted."

The oral examination in English will be conducted on January 30, 2023.

(In the case of many applications, we will conduct another examination on January 31, 2023.)

The oral examination may be changed to an online examination. The details will be announced on the GIP-TRIAD website when they are finalized.

The slides must be converted into a PDF file and both PowerPoint and PDF files must be sent to <a href="mailto:gip\_info@un.tsukuba.ac.jp">gip\_info@un.tsukuba.ac.jp</a> before 17:00 (Japan Standard Time) on January 23, 2023. On the examination day, bring your USB memory stick in which your presentation documents are saved.

### 9. Testing Location

#### 12. Enrollment Procedure

Follow the directions in the Enrollment Procedure Guidelines which will be sent out to successful applicants.

Expenses Required Upon Entrance

(1) Entrance fees: JPY 282,000(2) Yearly tuition: JPY 535,800

Academic year 2023 (September 2023 – March 2024): JPY 312,550

- \* Government-sponsored (Japanese Government *Monbukagakusho* Scholarship) foreign students are exempted from paying the entrance fees.
- \* The students of this program will rotate through the University of Tsukuba, University of Bordeaux, and National Taiwan University to spend a semester studying at each university. Students who have entered the University of Tsukuba through this examination will not be required to pay tuition or entrance fees to the University of Bordeaux or National Taiwan University.

  Expenses that need to be paid after enrollment include costs related to visa applications, travel

Expenses that need to be paid after enrollment include costs related to visa applications, travel expenses to France and Taiwan, living expenses, and insurance fees. In addition, costs related to any necessary infection control measures, such as pre-departure PCR examination fees and/or accommodation expenses during the required quarantine period, are to be borne by students.

#### Other Notes

Individuals with nationalities other than Japanese must follow the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act and be qualified for a resident status to enter graduate school before proceeding to the enrollment procedures.

Individuals who wish to enroll in the university as a foreign exchange student must qualify for a "Student" resident status.

Submit together with other required documents to the University.

Please pay at a convenience store using the URL above. After payment, take the "Application Fee Statement" and cut out the "Certificate of Payment" part, affix it to column "8" on the Application Form. Submit it to the University together with other required documents.

\*If the "Certificate of Payment" or the proof of payment is not affixed in the designated space of the Application Form, the application documents will not be accepted.


### (Paying at Convenience Store)
